Your dues are not deductible as a charitable contribution for federal income tax purposes. The 1994 Federal Revenue Reconciliation Act requires that dues payments, not associated with lobbying/advocacy, issued in 2022 may only deduct a percentage as an ordinary and necessary business expense. You will be notified in early 2023 the percentage of your 2022 dues that is deductible based on 2022 advocacy and lobbying efforts.
